EUCIS-LLL launched a feasibility study on the setting up of a European Lifelong Learning Institute in 2010. During this seminar, EUCIS-LLL will present its idea of setting up a Lifelong Learning Institute at European level on the basis of the study but also of the discussions that took place within its constituency in 2010-2011. The aim is to share our views with other stakeholders – public authorities, research institutes, civil society organizations and social partners – to exchange on the added value of this Institute for their organisations at European, national and local level.

Rationale

Today there is a lot of data on lifelong learning but it is still very difficult to access it. The aim of the European Institute on Lifelong Learning (EILL) is to investigate and transfer information on lifelong learning policies, strategies, systems and practices at European level. The institute will also serve as a transfer device between research, policy-making and practice ensuring greater transparency and cooperation between various actors. The unique feature of this institute is that it provides a civil society perspective on lifelong learning.
